Mr. Anurag Srivastava, IFS (1999), the Ambassador of India to the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia visited the Leather Industry Development Institute (LIDI), Ethiopia on 2nd November 2016.

Mr. Srivastava had useful discussions with Mr. Wondu Legesse, Director General and the team of Indian experts from Central Leather Research Institute (CLRI), Chennai, India and Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI), Noida, India on possibilities of enhancing cooperation under the existing 'Twinning Programme'.



LIDI & FDDI have shown interest in working together on the modalities of mutually beneficial partnership through collaborative programmes that are internationally & nationally recognized.

After successful completion of the Benchmarking Programme (2010-2011) in the several footwear companies in Ethiopia, FDDI (along with CLRI) had entered into agreement of 'Twinning Programme' with an objective to prepare, equip and graduate LIDI to meet the requirements of Ethiopian leather and leather products industry and trade so as to realize the national vision and aspirations.

In continuation of the Twinning Programme (Phase-1), FDDI has entered into another agreement of 'Twinning Programme (Phase-2)' on 8th May 2015 for two (02) years with the Ministry of Industry, Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia represented LIDI through CLRI.

Under the New agreement of Twinning (Phase-2), Establishment and conduct of training at Technical and Vocational



Education & Training (TVET) Centers in Ethiopia, Industrial Consultancy in Footwear Technology & Long-term & Short-term training program at FDDI will be undertaken by FDDI in addition to the ongoing B.Sc. programme with Addis Ababa Science & Technology University (AASTU) Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.
