NOTIFICATION

No.5 (18) 2002-Leather-in exercise of the powers conferred by para 5.1.3 of the guidelines issued along with Department on Industrial Policy and Promotion's Notification No.5 (18) 2002-Leather dated November 3, 2005, the Steering Committee being satisfied that it is necessary in public interest to do so, hereby makes the following amendments in the notification of the Government of India in the ministry of Commerce and Industry (Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) No.5 (18) 2002-Leather dated November 3, 2005

In the said guidelines para 2.1, which reads as "All existing units in leather and leather products including tanneries, leather goods, saddlery, leather footwear and footwear component sector undertaking viable and bankable programmes on technology up gradation on or after the date of Notification are eligible for assistance. Any unit existence for at least three years and having cash profits of at least two years on 3rd November, 2005 would be considered as an existing unit." is revised to effect as under: -

"All existing units in leather and leather products including tanneries, leather goods, saddlery, leather footwear and footwear component sector undertaking viable and bankable programmes on technology up gradation on or after the date of Notification i.e., 3rd November, 2005 are eligible for assistance .Any unit in existence for at least three years and having cash profits for at least two years at the time of undertaking viable and bankable programmes on technology up-gradation would be considered as an existing unit"

No.5 (18) 2002-Leather-in exercise of the powers conferred by para 5.1.3 of the guidelines issued along with Department on Industrial Policy and Promotion's Notification No.5 (18) 2002-Leather dated November 3, 2005, the Steering Committee being satisfied that it is necessary in public interest to do so in order to ensure the implementation of the scheme," Integrated Development of Leather Sector " (IDLS), hereby makes the following amendment in the Notification of Government of India in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) No.5 (18) 2002- leather dated November 3,2005 ,namely:-

In the said Notification: -

(1) In the guidelines: -

(1) Para 3.10 stands modified as under: -

“ The project Implementation Units under the Scheme, viz, Central Leather Research Institute (CLRI) for tanneries and Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI), footwear components, Leather goods & garments and saddlery may consider any other activity not listed above and machines not specified in the current guidelines for inclusion under the Scheme provide that they lead to visible and viable Improvements leading to technology up gradation. Similarly, the CLRI and FDDI may delete an activity /list of machineries. However, diversification will be treated as new venture and not allowed. Any addition or deletion or an activity /list of machineries by the PIU's would be done with prior intimation to the Steering Committee and the SIDBI”.
