

FDDI PROFILE

Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI) was set-up by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India in the year 1986 for the development and promotion of Footwear and Allied Product Industries.



Over the years, FDDI expanded into education in fashion, leather products, and retail & fashion merchandise and has been playing a pivotal role in facilitating Indian industry by bridging skill gaps in the areas of footwear, leather, fashion, retail and management.



FDDI has been functioning as an interface between the untapped talent and industry and its global counterparts, by fulfilling the demand of skilled manpower with its specific curriculum, state of the art laboratories, world class infrastructure and experienced faculty.





The Institute was given the status of 'Institution of National Importance' as per FDDI Act, 2017 for its contribution towards nation building by producing industry ready professionals and is serving as a 'One stop solutions provider' for footwear, leather and allied industry.





FDDI is imparting skill base training and education through its four schools namely, School of Footwear Design & Production (FDP), School of Fashion Design (FD), School of Leather Goods and Accessories Design (LGAD), and School of Retail and Fashion Merchandise (RFM).





SCHOOL OF FOOTWEAR DESIGN & PRODUCTION:

The School of Footwear Design & Production, established in 1986, is the oldest at FDDI. It has been at the fore-front of providing skilled based technical education and expertise in this sector propelling India to become second largest producer of footwear. The School actively contributes to developing the footwear sector in India and neighbouring countries/continents while focusing on competency building. Design Research & Innovation fosters an ideal atmosphere facilitated by the highend infrastructure equipped with the latest Design Software & CAD, 3D Printing, and related integrated technology.

SCHOOL OF FASHION DESIGN:

The School of Fashion Design at FDDI provides trained human resource by conducting training programs to suit the dynamic and fast-paced creative, and energetic fashion and apparel industry. The education program nurtures creativity while providing rigorous grounding in practical and technical skills needed for career success. With industry connections, we expose students to the latest trends and demands, preparing them for the real challenges of the fashion world.

SCHOOL OF LEATHER GOODS & ACCESSORIES DESIGN:

The training programs are designed and conducted at the school of Leather Goods & Accessories Design to suit varied human resource needs of the leather industry. As the demand for leather goods and garments has reached an all-time high, this school conducts training programmes which are intended to bridge the prevailing skill gap which impacts the quality of the product, reduce wastage, thereby bringing in process efficiency and business results. It combines core design subjects with interdisciplinary courses, allowing students to specialize in design and technology.

SCHOOL OF RETAIL & FASHION MERCHANDISE:

The programmes at the School of Retail and Fashion Merchandise are designed to improve retail operations & performance. It is aligned to improve retail operations consisting of supply chain and customer relations followed by merchandising, facilities management, vendor development etc. The school not only provides formal education but, also imparts practical job skills so as to make human resource functional on the very first day of work in the retail industry.

Besides the long-term programmes, for the Technological Upgradation & Competence Building of the Sector, the Institute conducts short-term Industry Specific Certificate Programmes also.

FDDI follows well researched and updated industry oriented curriculum. This methodology helps students nurture their skills and ambitions in a professional manner with the help of advanced learning material, practical experience through internships, job counselling, placement activities, and overall grooming of students into future executives.

For the purpose of upgrading the skill at grass route level, for the unorganized sector, FDDI has provided training to the artisans in remote villages/ SMEs clusters engaged in the leather/footwear sector by `spreading & sustaining a technology culture in the leather sector'.

It provided training to more than 20,000 artisans/SME's engaged in the leather sector from Saharanpur, Jaipur, Alwar, Patiala, Abohar, Fazialka, Muktsar & Malot.

FDDI is committed to provide all possible assistance to artisans related to footwear, handicrafts, handloom and leather industries in terms of promotion, design & technology for their products and other desired necessary training.

FDDI has completed 38 eventful years making significant contributions to the footwear, leather and allied industry through its academic programmes in design, technology and management, capacity building through skill up gradation to compete globally and offering technical assistance and support to the leather industry for product development, quality assurance, technology enhancement and other managerial, environmental and business solutions.





FDDI is known for nurturing high end trained specialized professionals through its programmes. The Institute has a strong Alumni base and strong industry linkage. Almost all the leading Industries of the country are associated with the Institute and have a key participation in academic matters such as Programme design, curriculum upgradation, expertise lectures, etc.



FDDI, after becoming an INI has the autonomy to design its courses, leading to Graduate, Post-graduate, Doctoral and Post-Doctoral Degrees, as per the requirement of the industry. With this new development, students would be able to apply for higher study and also apply for Central / State Government jobs.



Post-INI, the curriculum of FDDI has been upgraded by the faculty members based on the Industry inputs and further International Experts were roped-in to ensure that the various curriculums are in sync with the industry requirements and are of international standards.

To ensure international standards of education at FDDI, the Institute has entered into academic alliances with institutions of international repute like University of

Northampton – United Kingdom, ARSutoria School – Milan (Italy). FDDI has crossed the national boundaries and created a niche for itself in the area of Training and Consultancy in Asian countries like Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and many African countries like Ethiopia, Botswana, Nigeria, South Africa etc.




INTERNATIONAL TESTING CENTRE (ITC) $\; | \; | \; | \;$

FDDI has two International Testing Centre (ITC) one in North India (Noida) & other in South India (Chennai). ITC Noida is accredited by SATRA, United Kingdom (UK), & Bureau of Indian Standards. The ITC Chennai is also having accreditation from SATRA U.K.





The centre specializes in testing of leather, leather products, footwear (Safety, Fashion and Sports), footwear components, textile products & plastics.



It has been awarded the ISO 9001 and ISO 14001 and is approved by:

The ITC has full-fledged Chemical and Physical Laboratories, where all kind of chemicals and physical tests like AZO, PCP; Formaldehyde, Slip Resistance Hydrolysis etc., are performed within given Turn Around Time (TAT). The Physical laboratory was set up in collaboration with BALLY Switzerland under UNDP assistance.





Chemical laboratory has been set up in technical collaboration with PFI, Germany and is a leading testing laboratory of Asia. Both the labs have a complement of state-of-art testing equipments, duly calibrated and at par with the most demanding Industry standards.

The chemical laboratory is equipped with sophisticated instruments like High Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), UV-Visible Spectrometer, Gas Chromatography Coupled with Mass Spectrometer (GC-MS), Inductively Coupled Plasma with Mass Spectrometer (ICP-MS), Gas Chromatography with ECD & processing equipment for analysis.

The tests at the laboratory are conducted as per various standards depending on the customer's requirement. Reliability and authenticity is the watchword at these centres.

Through these labs, it provides testing services to leading brands like REEBOK, NIKE, ADIDAS, PUMA, FILA, BATA, Liberty, Red Chief, Khadim, Paragon, Super House, Sketchers and many more.



PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

> REVENUE & EXPENDITURE:

With respect to financial performance in FY 2023 24, the revenue was Rs. 128.22 Crores as against the total expenditure of Rs. 132.49 Crores. The total income from student fee is Rs.46,91,54,026.00.



One of the major challenges that the Institute faces is that FDDI being a self-financed Institute, receives grant for Capital Expenditure only. No Revenue grant is provided resulting in operational issues. Implementation charges of Government Schemes by FDDI and continuing education programmes contribute a small portion to meet our annual expenditure.

ADMISSION 2023-24:

To enhance admissions for the 2024 session, FDDI implemented a centralized admission team in Noida to oversee processes across campuses, ensuring efficiency and effectiveness. Awareness was amplified through school seminars, career fairs, coaching tie-ups, free counseling workshops, and participation in the UP International Trade Fair 2024 and India International Trade Fair 2024.

A robust multi-channel marketing strategy was deployed, leveraging social media platforms (Google Ads, Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, LinkedIn, X). Partnerships with educational portals likeCollege Dekho and College Duniya created detailed listings, while registrations with CUET, UCEED, and AIMA targeted UG and PG aspirants. Personalized communication through SMS, WhatsApp, and email campaigns enhanced engagement.

Financial support was prioritized through Canara Bank's Vidya Turant Scheme. Workshops, high-quality campus videos, and influencer collaborations further highlighted FDDI's unique value proposition, driving strong brand presence and lead generation.

These efforts resulted in a 22% growth in admissions compared to the 2023 session, marking a significant achievement in expanding the student base.

> TRANSFORMATION ACTIVITIES IN E-GOVERNANCE:

In line with its commitment to e-Governance, FDDI has implemented Campus Management Solution (CMS), an Academic ERP application, across all FDDI Campuses. Each session was designed with a dual purpose: to enhance theoretical knowledge and provide practical exposure. Industry veterans, entrepreneurs, and subject matter

experts were invited to lead these engagements, ensuring students had direct access to real-world expertise.

These initiatives underscore FDDI's commitment to bridging the gap between education and industry while nurturing future-ready professionals equipped to excel in their chosen fields.



> IMPLEMENTATION OF INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT OF LEATHER SECTOR (IDLS) SCHEME:

FDDI and CLRI are the two arms of Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) working as Project Implementation Unit (PIU) for the Product Sector for the Integrated Development of Leather Sector (IDLS) scheme.

During the year 2023-24, total 371 IDLS applications were received. PIU processed 325 applications and 235 applications were approved with total IDLS grant of 168.95 Cr.

> INTERNATIONAL CONSULTANCY:

Under Study in India Scheme of the Government of India, FDDI and Education Consultant of India Ltd., (EdCIL) have extended MoU for 2 years further up to 31st March 2024 for enhancing the reach of FDDI to the international students. Under this scheme, FDDI has offered 125 seats to international students in different programs. FDDI has developed website targeting international student under Study in India scheme (https://www.studyinindia.gov.in/institute_details?instituet_ID=SII-I-0269&active_tab_index=0).

FDDI had also joined the EducationINdia platform of the Ministry of External Affairs for synchronization of the foreign students related activities and expansion of the scope. FDDI has already become member for Atal Bihari Vajpayee General Scholarship Scheme of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

FDDI had conducted short term program in Footwear Design and Pattern Engineering for the design professionals of Leather Goods and Footwear Manufacturing Association of Bangladesh (LGFMAB) at Bangladesh for 10 students under FDDI-LFMEAB institutional collaboration program.

Another program for Leather Goods design is planned at FDDI, Kolkata.

FDDI had entered in to collaboration with Tomas Bata University for student exchange program, faculty exchange and joint research in the field of footwear technology and design. In addition to this, FDDI is also planning to commence international Ph.D. program in association with Tomas Bata University.

> MoU/MoA SIGNED:

FDDI's collaborations with industry and academia have strengthened significantly. MoUs and MoAs have been signed with Muzaffarpur Institute of Technology (MIT), Muzaffarpur & under the Convergence of Institutes with NIFT, Patna, Bihar for institutional collaboration in education, research outreach programmes, student exchange programme, faculty exchange and many more; with AIIMS, Hyderabad to Redefine Healthcare Footwear through research and innovation benefitting both healthcare professionals and patients.

Similarly, with Sharda University to work together for promotion of quality education, research & development with LCGC Resolute Group of Companies for IPR Training and Industrial Design Filing Facilitation Services to create a strong IP culture in the institution and appreciate new innovations and designs and seek timely registration of Ips.

> UPGRADATION OF FDDI'S INTERNATIONAL TESTING CENTRE (ITC):

FDDI has undertaken a significant initiative to enhance its International Testing Centres (ITC) located at Noida and Chennai. These centres have been restructured and equipped with state-of-the-art advanced testing machines, reflecting FDDI's commitment to providing cutting edge testing and inspection services. This modernization aims to ensure that the industry receives reliable, precise, and timely results, thereby supporting the manufacturing and production processes with world-class quality assurance.

To further bolster the capabilities of these centres and explore avenues for international collaboration in research and testing, FDDI engaged in meaningful discussions with Kerstin Schulte, Director - PFI (Prüf- und Forschungsinstitut), Germany, a globally recognized institute for testing and research in footwear and related industries. These discussions focused on potential partnerships to share expertise, improve methodologies, and jointly develop innovative testing solutions that meet global standards.

HINDI DEPARTMENT:

Recognizing its significant contribution for the progress of the Official Language Hindi, FDDI, Noida has been awarded with Consolation prize under the 'Rajbhasha Shield Yojna' for the outstanding work of the Official Language Hindi. The prize was given during the 45th meeting of the Town Official Language Implementation Committee (TOLIC) Office, Noida on August 23, 2023 which was held with the support of Directorate of Oil Industry Safety, OIDB Bhawan, Sector-73, Noida.

FDDI, Chennai students shine at TexFash'24



Engaging sessions and panel discussions brought together experts, educators, and stakeholders from across the country to delve into the nuances of the subject of discussion.


Industrial exposure for FDDI, Chennai students at NMZ Group and Shangavi Last Manufacturing Unit




FDDI, Ankleshwar & FDDI, Fursatganj holds its Convocation ceremony


