As a 'Fashion Expert and Garment Manufacturer', Ms. Maria Cote shared her experience working in the garment industry. She briefed about the market size and potential opportunities in the export business. She also explained about the impact of COVID – 19 pandemic on the market and the impact being felt globally.

To elucidate further, Mr. Saurabh explained that one needs to identify the market segment to target and the significant factors to be considered for deciding what kind of product one want to make. He shared a glimpse of how the market works in India and how every country has a different style and culture, which is why the product which works in one country might not work so well in others.





He explained that a product should have a unique selling point that can attract the funder to invest in the business. He discussed the key factors that an investor looks at while investing in a product.

During the webinar, Ms. Priya emphasized on the importance of developing an observing eye for the young designer so that they can have many different and innovative design inspirations in their work.

She also explained that one needs to be aware of what makes their culture unique which is a distinctive advantage and to try and foster this uniqueness within their textile art.


The second session focussed on the technical deliberations with faculties from Design department of all campuses for research and technical aspects of the footwear design.



The programme was attended by the students and staff of FDDI, Chandigarh (Banur) campus.


E-workshop 'Sneaker Design 2021 – 24 Hrs. Challenge' organized at FDDI, NOIDA

The students visited the Paragon-B footwear unit spread over 16 acres covering a large area making non-leather (upper & assembly). They got an exposure of production and bottoming techniques of PU and EVA soles and DIP (Direct Injection Process). During the visit, Mr. Sreejith Nair, General Manager, Hyderabad Division & his team briefed them about the sequence of operations used by the company for sandal making and safety shoes.



Later on, the students also visited its unit C, where the students were given a practical demonstration of how the soles are made from polymer-based raw materials.

In the second half, they visited Oblum Shoes Studio - a hand-made footwear brand located at Kavuri Hills, Hyderabad where they met the shoemaker, Mr. Tarun Oblum who makes leather shoes using hand tools.

Carefully crafted and boasting the highest level of elegance, its designs include penny loafers, brogues and lace-ups, in various shiny patinas and various skin tones. The students also got an opportunity to analyze the steps involved in hand made shoe(Good year welted) manufacturing & the working methods.

The purpose of this industrial exhibit was to provide students with an exposure to understand various functional areas in the production of n o n - l e a t h e r footwear and the handmade footwear making.

Industrial Exposure for FDDI, Fursatganj students at Kanpur Leather cluster

On 12th November 2021, over 45 students of B.Des. FDP 2019 batch of FDDI, Fursatganj campus visited two leading leather and footwear-manufacturing units located in Kanpur Leather cluster.

Kings International (Tannery & Saddlery Unit), a manufacturer and exporter of saddler and harness since past 25 years and in the second half visited Suri Shoes, a footwear production house since past 27 years.

At M/s. Kings International, Mr. Amir briefed the students on the procedures of how raw animal skins undergo several procedures to get converted into a final usable hide. He also explained about the important parameters required for the leather processing; starting from the preservation of raw skin to the final export, the technologies involved, the usage of various chemicals and their concentrations, which are involved, in the leather manufacturing process.



At Suri Shoes, the students were briefed about the different types of footwear constructions, maintenance of the machines involved, finishing of the final products, final packaging, and dispatching of the goods by Mr. N.K Srivastava (Sr. Production Manager). He also explained them about the footwear conveyor system, Desma pouring machine, pre-fab operations, etc.

The industrial exposure helped the students to understand the sequence of operation starting from cutting, sizing, stitching, sorting, polishing, testing to quality control, etc. and acquire the requisite professional skill-set of the industry.

Insightful webinar 'Learn to Lean' held at FDDI, Chennai campus



All the jury members thanked FDDI for organizing the training workshop on Leather Goods making and requested FDDI to start more training workshops in Jammu & Kashmir.


