




# SMART MATERIAL & SENSOR

A five-day workshop on Smart Materials and Sensor-Based Product Design was conducted in December to introduce students to the practical application of electronics and IoT in fashion, lifestyle, and leather products. Throughout the workshop, students learned to work with breadboards, microcontrollers, and various sensors related to motion, security, environment, and interaction.

The workshop emphasized hands-on learning, resulting in several working prototypes such as an anti-theft jewellery bag developed using motion sensors, as well as a room temperature and humidity detector. Students also explored concepts like odour-sensing shoe boxes and smart storage solutions, focusing on real-world problems and user needs. By integrating smart technology with design thinking, students gained valuable skills in creating functional, innovative, and future-ready products. The workshop enabled them to apply these learnings to academic projects, portfolios, and industry-oriented design solutions, bridging the gap between traditional design and emerging smart systems.





# COMBINED TERM PROJECT

## *Display*

The students of 3rd Semester LLPD organized a classroom display as part of their Combined Term Project, showcasing a diverse range of creative and material-based works. The display featured three unstitched bags, along with metal, clay, and wooden products, reflecting the students' hands-on exploration of different materials and techniques.

A key highlight of the display was a metal bike sculpture created using scrap materials. With the support of the lab assistant, students painted the sculpture to depict an accident scene, adding strong narrative and visual impact. The display also included handmade paper art pieces and a large art installation suspended from the ceiling, enhancing the classroom's spatial experience.

Overall, the students worked collaboratively to transform their classroom into an art-gallery-like space, focusing on presentation, storytelling, and visual coherence. The display successfully demonstrated their creativity, material understanding, and ability to curate an immersive exhibition environment.




# TANNERY TRAINING



During the visit, the tannery staff provided an engaging and detailed demonstration of each machine, highlighting their capabilities and the cutting-edge technology involved. The laboratories, meticulously maintained at precise temperatures, offered an ideal environment for hands-on learning. This practical exposure to the manufacturing process enabled students to clearly understand how theoretical concepts are applied in real-world industrial settings.

# INDUSTRIAL VISIT



As part of the industrial visit, the students were taken to D2 International for a guided tour of the factory and industry operations. During the visit, students carefully observed and gained an in-depth understanding of the functioning of various departments, processes, and workflow involved in bag manufacturing.



Following the tour, students were provided with hands-on training in edge colouring, allowing them to apply practical skills under industry conditions. To encourage excellence, the three best-performing students in edge colouring were recognized and awarded prizes by the organization, which motivated students and enhanced their learning experience.

On the following day, students received detailed exposure to jigs, including their role and importance in bag manufacturing. They were taught how jigs are designed, manufactured, used, and stored for future production, helping them understand precision, efficiency, and standardization in industrial processes.

Overall, the industrial visit proved to be a valuable learning experience, effectively bridging theoretical knowledge with real-world manufacturing practices.

# PRE-PLACEMENT TRAINING PROGRAM

# END OF AN ERA: ANNA WINTOUR STEPS DOWN AFTER 37 YEARS AT AMERICAN VOGUE



After an unprecedented 37-year run as editor-in-chief of American Vogue, iconic fashion executive Anna Wintour has stepped down from the role, marking the end of one of the most influential editorial tenures in modern media history. Wintour, 75, who first took the helm in 1988 and helped shape Vogue into a global fashion authority, will remain with the publication as its Global Editorial Director and serve as Chief Content Officer for Condé Nast, continuing to oversee content across the company's major titles.

Replacing her as the top editorial leader for the U.S. edition is Chloe Malle, Vogue.com's former editor and co-host of the magazine's podcast *The Run-Through*, who has been named Head of Editorial Content. In her new role, effective immediately, Malle will lead the day-to-day editorial and creative direction of American Vogue, bringing her digital expertise and multi-platform experience to the forefront.

Malle joined Vogue in 2011 and has risen through the ranks, playing a pivotal role in expanding the brand's digital reach. Wintour's transition reflects a broader editorial restructuring at Condé Nast while ensuring her strategic influence endures across global publications and flagship events like the Met Gala.



## Jonathan Anderson Wins Designer of the Year at The Fashion Awards for Third Consecutive Year

LONDON — Renowned fashion designer Jonathan Anderson has been named Designer of the Year at The Fashion Awards 2025, marking his third consecutive win in this prestigious category. The annual ceremony, held at the Royal Albert Hall, celebrates outstanding talent and innovation in the global fashion industry.

Anderson, who serves as creative director of Dior and leads his own label JW Anderson, was honoured for his influential design work and continued impact on contemporary fashion. His win underscores his position as one of the most significant creative voices in the industry today.


The event also recognised other key figures, including celebrated designers and creatives honoured across various categories, highlighting the diversity and dynamism of fashion talent worldwide.

## Met Gala 2026 Theme Announced as “Costume Art”

The Metropolitan Museum of Art has revealed that the theme for the 2026 Met Gala and its accompanying spring exhibition will be “Costume Art,” celebrating fashion as a form of artistic expression and its deep connection to the human body and visual culture. The annual fundraising gala — fashion’s most anticipated night — will take place on Monday, May 4, 2026, leading into the opening of the Costume Art exhibition.

Curated by the Costume Institute, the exhibition and gala theme explore the representation of clothing alongside historical and contemporary artworks, underlining the significant role of dress in art and society. The event coincides with the launch of major new galleries at The Met, marking an important chapter in the museum’s celebration of fashion history and its artistic impact.

The 2026 gala will be co-chaired by a star-studded lineup including Beyoncé, Nicole Kidman, Venus Williams, and Anna Wintour, promising one of the most watched and stylish red-carpet events yet as celebrities interpret the “Costume Art” theme through their fashion choices.
