






Online session demonstrating custom virtual fit model


The webinar was organized by School of Retail and Fashion Merchandising of FDDI, which provided an insight to the students on the importance of digital marketing in today's business world.



Ms. Manali Anand, Digital Marketing & Soft Skill Speaker



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
