With an objective to provide a chance to add new skills in attainment of the professional goal of the students, a four days e-workshop on 'Make-up & Styling' was organized by Footwear Design & Development Institute (FDDI), NOIDA campus from 21st January 2022 to 18th February 2022.

It was organized by FDDI School of Fashion Design (FSFD) during which the Specialized Faculty of India's leading beauty and wellness care institution - Vandana Luthra Curls and Curves (VLCC) conducted enlightening and knowledge powering sessions by introducing the students and faculty to the artistry behind make-up & styling.

During the e-workshop on 'Professional Make-Up', Ms. Kajal Singh provided insights and demonstrated the looks of both female and male models and gave a very natural look to both of them. For the female model, she went for natural brown lips and soft eyeshadow, furthermore told about the recent eyeliner trends and how one can achieve a similar look using eyeshadow instead of eyeliner.

During the session, she explained the importance of nicely shaped eyebrows, whereas, for the male model makeup, she taught us how to blend in the foundation with facial hair and achieve a natural no-makeup look.

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During the e-workshop on 'Make-Up and Draping', Ms. Kajal Singh explained about the intricacies of party-wear makeup and drape different styles of sarees. Under the makeup tutorial, she briefed on CTM (cleanser, toner, moisturizer).

She shared her expertise about airbrush makeup and explained the difference between airbrush and traditional makeup. Furthermore, she recommended a few makeup brands for various skin types and draped three saree styles which included the traditional saree, the chic saree, and the dhoti saree, along with tips and tricks for easy saree draping.

During the e-workshop on 'Hair Styling', Mr. Bhanu Mendiratta provided valuable tips on hairstyling machines, brushes, and products. He briefed about the importance of using the right kind of products for different hair types to avoid damage including live demonstrations about making a low bun and explained all the steps involved.

During the e-workshop on 'Skin Care', Ms. Reshu Agarwal briefed about the importance of using sunscreen and the right skincare. She explained about various skin types and how to take care of one's skin. She also explained why different skin types need different care and vary according to geographic locations.
